South Kaipara Landcare Event

World Wetland Day takes place annually to draw attention to the decline in wetland areas and encourage their preservation. The South Kaipara Landcare group is to hold a special event on Saturday 13 February on the property of the NZ Native Forests Restoration Trust at Tupare where a nature sanctuary, the Marie Neverman Reserve, is being cared for on the site known locally as Leighton's Dam.

Protecting the wildlife values of the lake and wetland is the theme of the day. There will be short talks from 10am followed by visits to viewing points and a BBQ lunch at noon. To reach the venue from South Head Road, about 1km south of Shelly Beach junction, turn on to Tuparekura Road then left into Kaipara Lake Road. There is easy access for parking.
