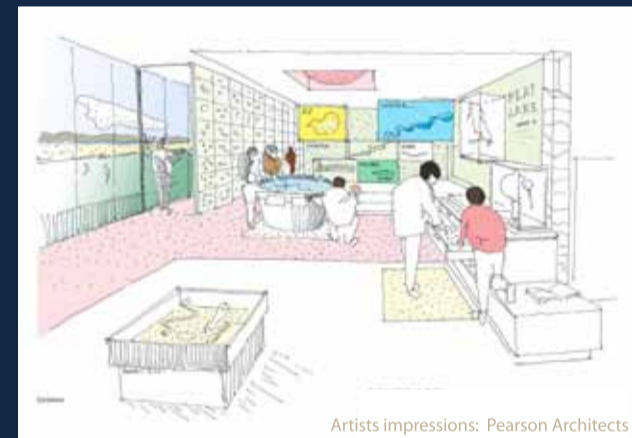

To build and operate a national visitor centre (located in the Waikato) where locals, schools, landowners and tourists can learn about our lakes, swamps, bogs and estuaries.

- Interactive walk highlighting the local wetland and wildlife experience: peat lakes, restored bogs, and mature kahikatea stands, within a pest-free sanctuary.
