The National Wetland Trust wants to attract wildlife, as well as people, to its proposed national wetland centre in the Waikato. We plan to:

- Build a predator-proof fence around East Lake, remove all introduced predators and create a haven for native wildlife.
- Explore the option of reintroducing species lost from many unprotected wetlands (e.g. brown teal, crakes and mudfish).
- Restore the lake margin vegetation to provide good wildlife habitat and protect water quality.
- Complement conservation work by NZ Landcare Trust, Waipa District Council and Conservation Volunteers.

Wetland centre visitors will be able to picnic with pateke, wander with wading birds, dabble with dabchicks, and kayak with kokopu.
